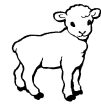

VBS: "FAITH EXPEDITION" AT WRPC JUNE 23RD—27TH, 8:45 AM—12 NOON

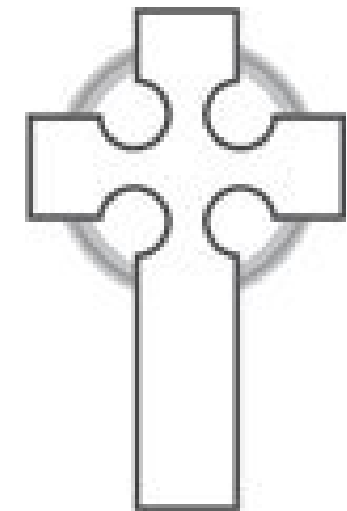
