<sup>1</sup>Now the serpent was more crafty than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, "Indeed, has God said, 'You shall not eat from any tree of the garden?'"

<sup>2</sup>The woman said to the serpent, "From the fruit of the trees of the garden we may eat; <sup>3</sup>but from the fruit of the tree which is in the middle of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat from it or touch it, or you will die.'"

<sup>4</sup>The serpent said to the woman, "You surely will not die!"

<sup>5</sup>"For God knows that in the day you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil."

<sup>6</sup>When the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was desirable to make one wise, she took from its fruit and ate; and she gave also to her husband with her, and he ate.

<sup>7</sup>Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves loin coverings.

<sup>8</sup>They heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden.

<sup>9</sup>Then the LORD God called to the man, and said to him, "Where are you?"

<sup>10</sup>He said, "I heard the sound of You in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; so I hid myself."

<sup>11</sup>And He said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you not to eat?"

<sup>12</sup>The man said, "The woman whom You gave to be with me, she gave me from the tree, and I ate."

<sup>13</sup>Then the LORD God said to the woman, "What is this you have done?" And the woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."

<sup>14</sup>The LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, Cursed are you more than all cattle, And more than every beast of the field;

On your belly you will go,  
And dust you will eat  
All the days of your life;  
<sup>15</sup>And I will put enmity  
Between you and the woman,  
And between your seed and her seed;  
He shall bruise you on the head,  
And you shall bruise him on the heel."

<sup>16</sup>To the woman He said,  
"I will greatly multiply  
Your pain in childbirth,  
In pain you will bring forth children;  
Yet your desire will be for your husband,  
And he will rule over you."

<sup>17</sup>Then to Adam He said, "Because you have listened to the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree about which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat from it';

Cursed is the ground because of you;  
In toil you will eat of it  
All the days of your life.

<sup>18</sup>"Both thorns and thistles it shall grow for you;  
And you will eat the plants of the field;

<sup>19</sup>By the sweat of your face  
You will eat bread,  
Till you return to the ground,  
Because from it you were taken;  
For you are dust,  
And to dust you shall return."

<sup>20</sup>Now the man called his wife's name Eve, because she was the mother of all the living.

<sup>21</sup>The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife, and clothed them.

<sup>22</sup>Then the LORD God said, "Behold, the man has become like one of Us, knowing good and evil; and now, he might stretch out his hand, and take also from the tree of life, and eat, and live forever"--

<sup>23</sup>therefore the LORD God sent him out from the garden of Eden, to cultivate the ground from which he was taken.

<sup>24</sup>So He drove the man out; and at the east of the garden of Eden He stationed the cherubim and the flaming sword which turned every direction to guard the way to the tree of life.

<sup>4</sup>When they arrived at Jerusalem, they were received by the church and the apostles and the elders, and they reported all that God had done with them.

<sup>5</sup>But some of the sect of the Pharisees who had believed stood up, saying, "It is necessary to circumcise them and to direct them to observe the Law of Moses."

<sup>6</sup>The apostles and the elders came together to look into this matter.

<sup>7</sup>After there had been much debate, Peter stood up and said to them, "Brethren, you know that in the early days God made a choice among you, that by my mouth the Gentiles would hear the word of the gospel and believe.

<sup>8</sup>"And God, who knows the heart, testified to them giving them the Holy Spirit, just as He also did to us;

<sup>9</sup>and He made no distinction between us and them, cleansing their hearts by faith.

<sup>10</sup>"Now therefore why do you put God to the test by placing upon the neck of the disciples a yoke which neither our fathers nor we have been able to bear?"

<sup>11</sup>"But we believe that we are saved through the grace of the Lord Jesus, in the same way as they also are."

<sup>12</sup>All the people kept silent, and they were listening to Barnabas and Paul as they were relating what signs and wonders God had done through them among the Gentiles.

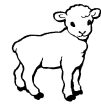

The church office will be closed on **Friday, July 4<sup>th</sup>**, for the holiday.

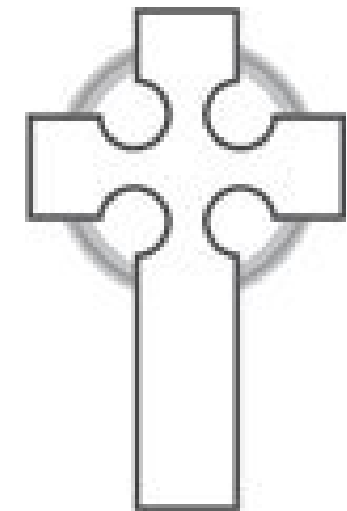
