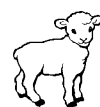

The Adult Choir (Jr. High & up) will rehearse Wednesdays, 6:00—6:40 PM, beginning February 4th; newcomers are welcome!



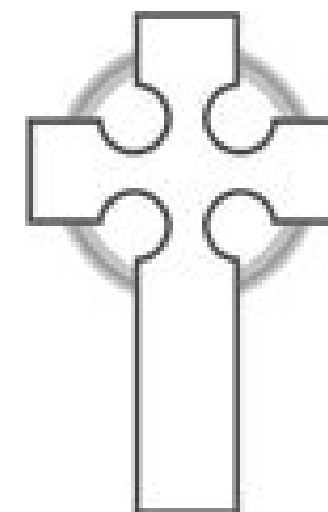
