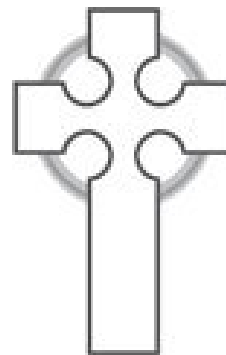

<sup>11</sup>At the end of three months we set sail on an Alexandrian ship which had wintered at the island, and which had the Twin Brothers for its figurehead.  
<sup>12</sup>After we put in at Syracuse, we stayed there for three days.  
<sup>13</sup>From there we sailed around and arrived at Rhegium, and a day later a south wind sprang up, and on the second day we came to Puteoli.  
<sup>14</sup>There we found some brethren, and were invited to stay with them for seven days; and thus we came to Rome.  
<sup>15</sup>And the brethren, when they heard about us, came from there as far as the Market of Appius and Three Inns to meet us; and when Paul saw them, he thanked God and took courage.  
<sup>16</sup>When we entered Rome, Paul was allowed to stay by himself, with the soldier who was guarding him.  
<sup>17</sup>After three days Paul called together those who were the leading men of the Jews, and when they came together, he began saying to them, "Brethren, though I had done nothing against our people or the customs of our fathers, yet I was delivered as a prisoner from Jerusalem into the hands of the Romans.  
<sup>18</sup>"And when they had examined me, they were willing to release me because there was no ground for putting me to death.  
<sup>19</sup>"But when the Jews objected, I was forced to appeal to Caesar, not that I had any accusation against my nation.  
<sup>20</sup>"For this reason, therefore, I requested to see you and to speak with you, for I am wearing this chain for the sake of the hope of Israel."  
<sup>21</sup>They said to him, "We have neither received letters from Judea concerning you, nor have any of the brethren come here and reported or spoken anything bad about you.  
<sup>22</sup>"But we desire to hear from you what your views are; for concerning this sect, it is known to us that it is spoken against everywhere."

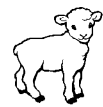

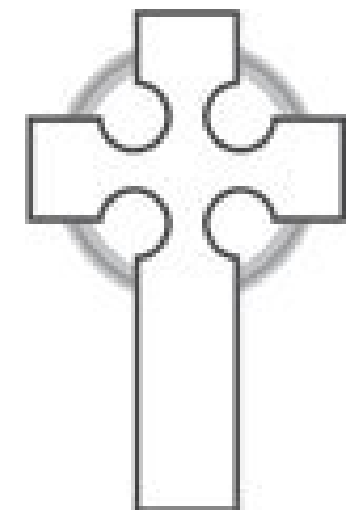
